Competition Rules

The Basics

1. These competition rules and those on the Sign Up page (<http://conservationcup.co.nz/sign-up/>) form the terms and conditions for the competition (the **Rules**).
2. By entering the competition, you agree to the Rules.
3. Until a prize is awarded, TORQUE IP can cancel or change the competition or any of the Rules at any time, for any reason. Changes will take effect when they are posted in the Rules. A Rule change notification email will be sent to all entrants.
4. TORQUE IP has the final say on the competition and the Rules and TORQUE IP's decision will be final; no correspondence will be entered into. Basically, what we say goes.
5. To enter the competition, you must be a registered New Zealand School and meet all criteria found on the Sign Up page of the website - <http://conservationcup.co.nz/sign-up/>.
6. We need to make sure our competitions are all above board, so unfortunately you're not allowed to enter if you're connected to TORQUE IP or the competition. This applies to employees of TORQUE IP, EECA, any company involved in the competition and TORQUE IP's subsidiaries and commercially owned entities.
7. When applying, you must tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth.
8. Unless we've stated otherwise, the number of entries are based on the below:
Conservation Cup Champion – one entry per school
Conservation Cup Runner Up – one entry per school
Weekend Warrior - one entry per school
Biggest Blogger - one entry per student
Movie Maker - one entry per student
Best CC Promotion – one entry per school
Best Poster - one entry per student
9. We've let you know the entry period in the competition notice. Sorry, but we can only accept entries received during this time.
10. We need to receive your entry to put you into the competition. So unfortunately, if the postie loses it, or a cyber-thief intercepts it, you won't be entered.
11. We can disqualify you if we think that you've breached any of the Rules. But we're nice guys, so we'll be fair about it.
12. We won't return your entry.
13. We can publish your name in connection with the competition. You also agree that we can take photos and videos of you to use for publicity purposes. Be sure to smile!
14. We won't be responsible for any loss or damage suffered by you or anyone else in connection with the competition, or your use of the prize (if you win). If the competition is being run through

the Dashboard interface, Facebook or any other medium we have posted as a conduit for competition entry points, you agree that they will not have any responsibility either.

15. Sometimes things don't go as planned. If our competition is derailed for any reason, e.g. infection by computer virus (oh no!), unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or zombie apocalypse (What?), we will have the right to cancel, postpone or change the competition. We will do our absolute best to avoid this.

16. TORQUE IP respects privacy rights under the Privacy Act 1993. That means there are a bunch of rules that we stick to, particularly around collecting your personal information and not sharing them with anyone.

17. These Rules and the competition will be run under NZ law.

If you win

18. We'll contact you to say Congratulations, and arrange a time to meet with you. (These days, its usually email or phone.) If we can't get hold of you within a month of the competition closing, we'll have to select another winner. So keep your phone handy!

19. Any material that is created for or as part of the competition is under the ownership of the creator but the creator will freely license said material to Torque IP for promotion and marketing of Torque IP and its services as Torque IP sees fit.

20. Unfortunately prizes can't be traded in for cash. Unless of course they're cash prizes. Then you'll get cash.

21. Prizes are personal to the winners and can't be transferred to someone else unless TORQUE IP agrees. If you can't accept a prize for any reason (e.g. you can't travel on the necessary dates), we can award the prize to another winner.

22. If you're disqualified for any breach of these Rules (e.g. we find out you don't match the eligibility criteria), we'll choose another winner.

23. It doesn't happen often, but sometimes we need to change a prize. If we do this, well swap it out for something of equal value (or even more!).

24. If we ask, you agree to appear in a promo (for free) for TORQUE IP or the competition promoter.

25. Sometimes there may be tax implications with winning a prize. We wouldn't want there to be any surprises for you, so suggest you talk to someone about this before you accept the prize.
